



Weather Policy

North Elmham Trailblazers

Trailblazers Netball is played outdoors and sometimes might need to be delayed or cancelled due to extreme weather, especially as we move into the winter season.

Whilst the club makes every effort to train in all scheduled time slots, should conditions become unmanageable due to weather conditions (heavy rain/temp etc), the club has a duty-of-care to its players and officials, and reserve the right to postpone or cancel training for any/all groups before or during the session.

Extreme weather is considered excessive heat/cold, high winds, rain, hail and lightning, or weather that may affect the safety of players such as ice or water on court, increasing the risk of slips and falls.

Trailblazers Netball Club observe the official weather warnings, advice and weather predictions given by the Met Office, and make a final decision based on those guidelines, or on a visible inspection of the outdoor courts if needed. We aim to provide as much notice as possible, or by 3pm on the day of play at the latest.

If training sessions are going ahead, you must ensure that you, or your child comes to the session in appropriate clothing and footwear ready to play; the courts at North Elmham are very exposed and subject to strong, cold winds so all players need to come fully prepared with multiple layers, coats, hat, gloves, footwear with good grip etc.

We fully support any decision to not send your child to a session if you feel the weather is too extreme, but we do ask you to either change your response on that week's session WhatsApp Poll or let us know as soon as possible if no poll is sent.
